

## OUR VALUES




- **Inspiration**


## OUR CARE UNITS



**St-Martin Neuro Psychiatric Hospital (HNP) has 9 mixed care units on its site in Dave :**

- **Galiléo** : unit specialised in neurobehavioural and neuro-cognitive disorders
- **Kalamos** : unit specialised in mood disorders, anxiety disorders and eating disorders in young adults (aged 18–25)
- **L'Athantor** : unit specialised in social phobias, school phobias, high potential, cyber addiction, (cyber)bullying, eating disorders, depression and anxiety in adolescents (aged 15–18)
- **L'OASIS** : unit specialised in forensic psychiatry and care for patients hospitalised in the framework of the protection law for mentally ill persons
- **Gomyé** : unit specialised in dual diagnosis : intellectual disability and mental health
- **Revivo** : unit specialised in general psychiatry and addiction
- **Edrano** : specialised unit for patients aged 60 and over with psychiatric disorders, with or without mild to moderate cognitive impairment
- **PHILEAS** : unit specialised in forensic psychiatry, in relation to TSI St-Martin
- **HIC unit** : High & Intensive Care psychiatric unit, for voluntary hospitalisation coordinated with the network, for adults facing acute mental health situations

### HNP in figures - year 2025



**On the site of Dave**, for inpatients or day patients :

- the **Espace CADences**, Centre for Therapeutic Activities at CNP St-Martin, is a space dedicated to treatment through activity. It also offers patients ongoing support in their social rehabilitation and independence.
- the **Polyclinic** extends the care offer in terms of psychiatric, neurological and somatic follow-up care.

**Off-site**, our two hospitals, «**Mosaïques**» and «**Le Kiosque**», respectively located in the heart of the cities of Jambes and Ciney, offer day hospital mental care.

### CNP St-Martin has three mixed psychiatric care homes (MSP) : Sénévé - Mériba - Les Entours

St-Martin's MSP are living or transition places for people suffering from a stabilized psychiatric problem and/or suffering from slight to moderate intellectual deficiency.

The MSP receive persons who are not able to live independently but who possibly have the potential to do so.

Each of the 3 MSP Saint-Martin has its own specific features.
