

## The ELEA project

According to the needs of **asylum seekers and refugees with psychological difficulties** (exile, rupture, isolation, asylum procedure, mourning, etc), we offer the intervention of an **assistance team of confidants**.

This team aims at **ensuring the access to a specific care path** based on the collaboration with **CNP Saint-Martin**, its various services (hospitalizations, psychiatric consultations) and its **psychosocial workers' network**.

The team's service falls within the **perspective of integration, non-stigmatization and recovery of people**. To this end, **ELEA promotes access to a care path**.

## The project

Initiated in 2016 in collaboration with Fedasil as part of the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund (AMIF), the ELEA project is carried out by L'OASIS care unit of St-Martin Neuro Psychiatric Centre in Dave.

Developed in the philosophy of the mental health care reform, ELEA aims at providing an easier access to a health care path for asylum seekers and refugees with psychological difficulties.



## Our missions

To provide **support** and facilitate **access to care for asylum seekers and refugees with psychological difficulties**.

We offer different kinds of interventions :

- **Analyze the situation and assess** the needs for a psychiatric follow-up and treatment.
- **Contribute to the orientation** of asylum seekers and refugees with psychological difficulties towards an adapted care path, depending on individual situations.
- **Intervene during the care path** of the person with the residential and ambulatory care teams by supporting and accompanying the therapeutic actions put in place.
- **Facilitate access to a psychiatric care** for outpatients and residents.

## Our team

ELEA is a mobile team supporting asylum seekers and refugees. This team consists of :

- 1 coordinator
- 1 medical coordinator - a psychiatrist
- 2 psychosocial workers

## Target group

- **Asylum seekers or refugees** who may have **psychological problems** which may require assistance and treatment in an outpatient or residential setting.
- **Psycho-medical and social teams** who seek support in the assistance of these people.
